Title IX Complaints at CHIME follow the process set up by the Universal Complaint procedure established by CHIME Institute. Please, also know that as a parent or student of the school you have rights under the law for Title IX. These rights can be found in the Title IX guide below.

Complaint Process

Students or parents/guardians should report their verbal or written Title IX complaint to the school administrator or Title IX/Bullying Complaint Manager within six months from the date the alleged incident occurred or first obtained knowledge. Complainants have a right to a timely and informal resolution at the school site.

If the complainant is dissatisfied with the school-site or Local District decision, the complainant may file a written <u>Uniform Complaint Procedures (UCP)</u> complaint directly with the Educational Equity Compliance Office. This will begin the investigation process which must be completed within 60 days. An appeal of the Educational Equity Compliance Office's findings may be made to the California Department of Education - Office of Equal Opportunity.
