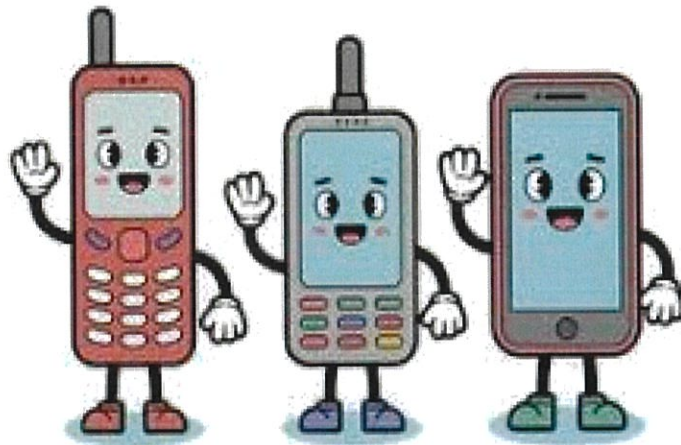

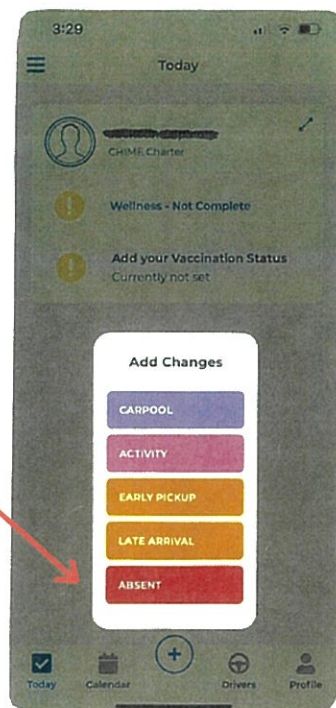

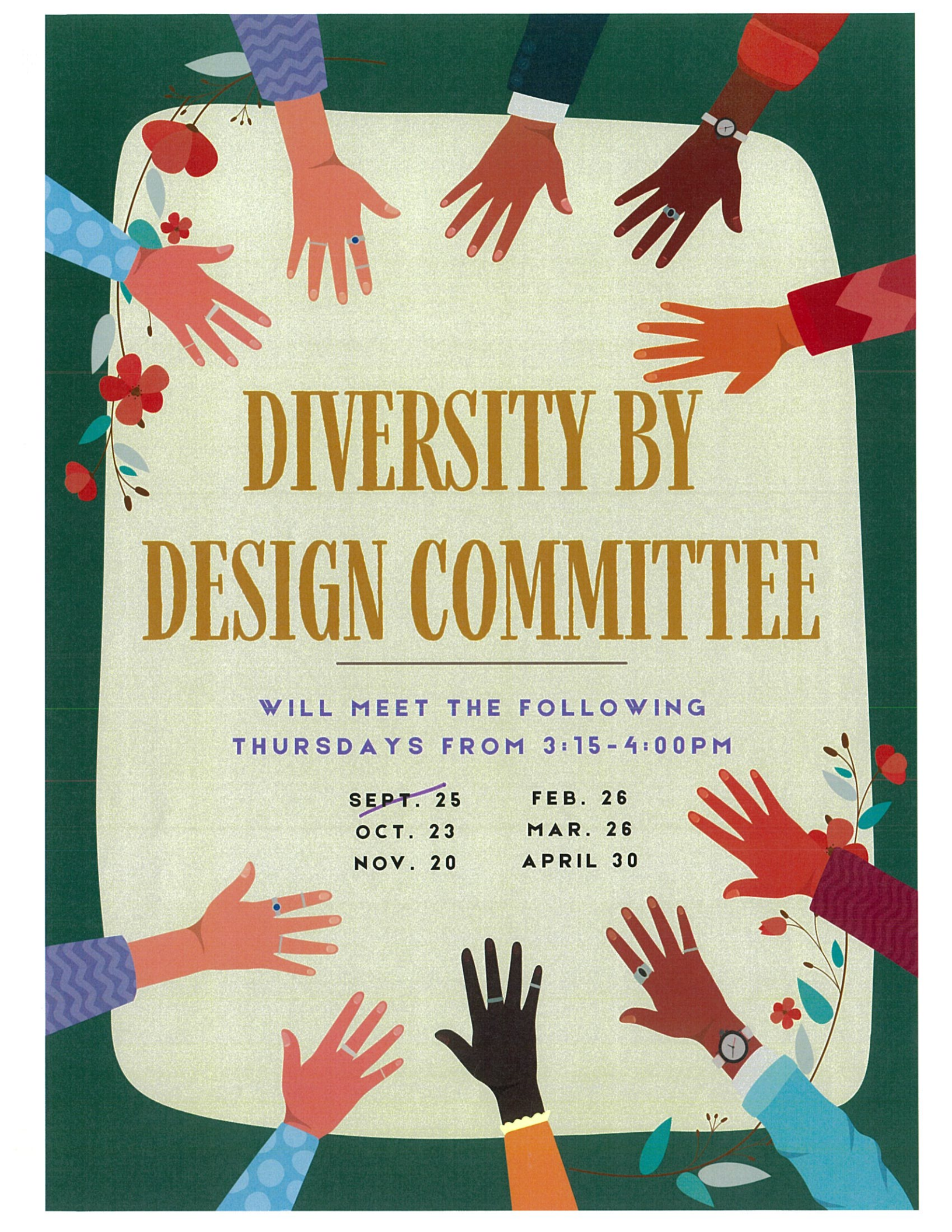

CHIME CHARTER SCHOOL'S COSTUME POLICY

We want Halloween to be fun and safe.

All students in grades TK-8 may come to school in their costumes,
if the following guidelines are met.

PARENTS: Please help support an appropriate, distraction-free learning environment for all students by ensuring that your student adheres to these guidelines.

1. Please use good judgment and keep all costumes sensible; they should be appropriate for a school environment. If you have questions about your costume, please ask Ms. Healey, Mrs. Goodman or Ms. Furnback.
2. **No potentially dangerous costume props allowed (swords, knives, pitchforks, wands, chains, etc.).** We don't want anyone to get injured. All props will be held in the office and can be picked up by a parent or guardian after school.
3. Profanity may not be displayed on the costumes.
4. **No full-face masks.** We need to be able to see who you are! Make-up is acceptable. No fake blood, please.
5. Regular, closed toed shoes must be worn at all times. For safety reasons, spike heels, roller skates, sandals, flip flops or another inappropriate footwear may not be worn. Two-inch heels are acceptable.
6. Strapless dresses may not be worn, but spaghetti straps or tank tops are O.K.
7. You may come to school with your hair sprayed and appropriate make-up on. (No dressing or applying of make-up or colored hairspray once students arrive at school.)

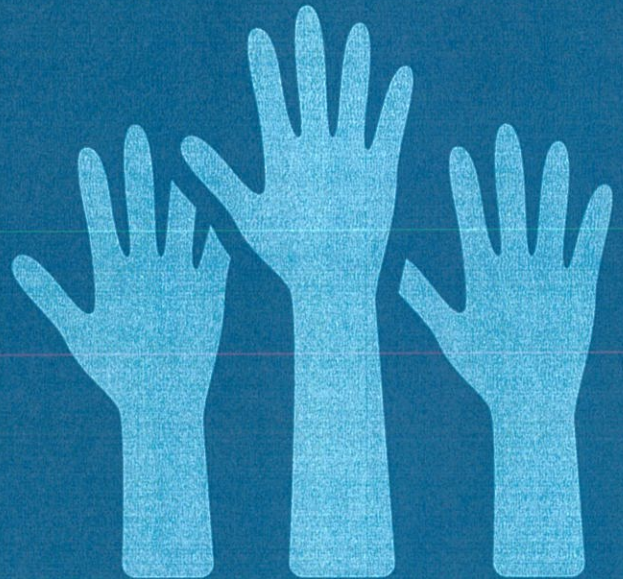

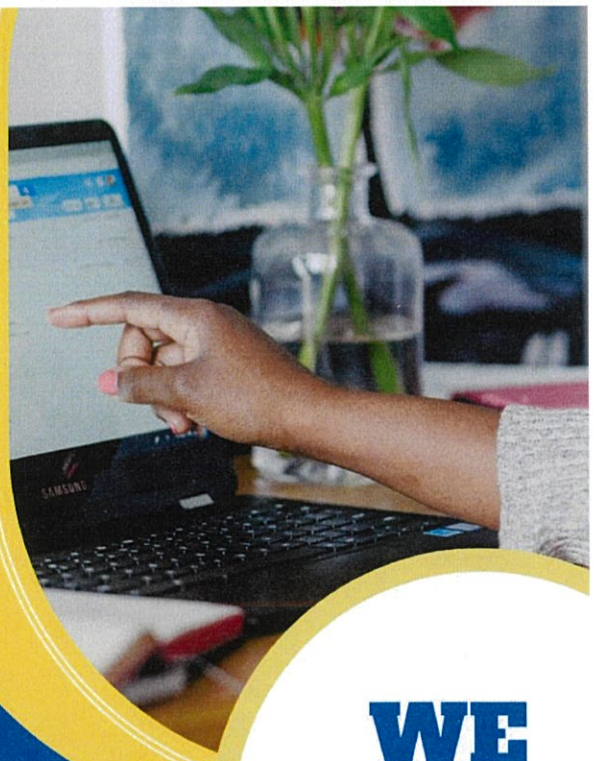

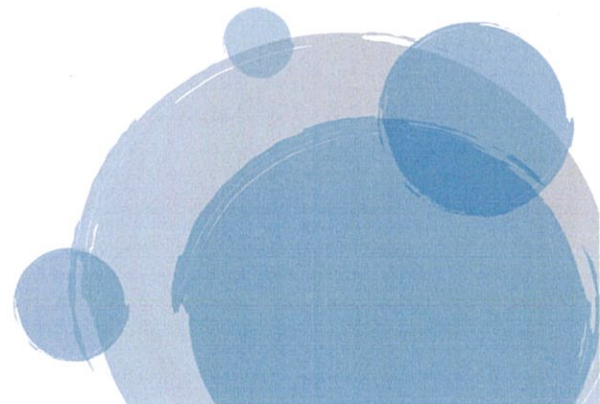
