





PARENTS: Please help support an appropriate, distraction-free learning environment for all students by ensuring that your student adheres to these guidelines.

- 1. Please use good judgment and keep all costumes sensible; they should be appropriate for a school environment. If you have questions about your costume, please ask Ms. Healey, Mrs. Goodman or Ms. Furnback.
- 2. No potentially dangerous costume props allowed (swords, knives, pitchforks, wands, chains, etc.). We don't want anyone to get injured. All props will be held in the office and can be picked up by a parent or guardian after school.
