HOW TO BUILD AN OUTREACH KIT FOR PEOPLE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS

STEP 1 – GATHER

Go to the “Travel Size” (miniature size) toiletry/personal hygiene item section of your local drug store, supermarket, or department store, and purchase an assortment of toiletry items

STEP 2 – ASSEMBLE

Place items in an extra-large One-Gallon-sized Ziploc Food Storage bag. Place completed Hygiene Kits in large shopping bags to make transport and distribution easier.

THINGS YOUR KIT SHOULD INCLUDE:

- Soap or Body Wash
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Shampoo
- Conditioner
- Hair Brush or Comb
- Deodorant
- Chapstick
- Nail Clippers
- Non-Perishable Snack (No Granola Bars. Too hard for their teeth)
- Bottled Water (Mini Size)
- Hand Sanitizer
- Sunscreen
- Tampons (for Women’s Kits)
(Tampons are the #1 most needed personal hygiene item by homeless women)
- Rain Poncho
- 70% male geared kits,
30% female-geared kits
(including feminine hygiene products)
