Students are provided with art and music classes weekly in grades TK -8th grade and are offered a large slate of art electives in grades 6-8, including band, drawing, visual arts, and film. Supplemental staffing, supplies, equipment, and educational opportunities have been added since the advent of the Prop 28 funding program. CHIME believes that arts education is an integral part of the education experience of our students
